REBUILDING THE CIRCLE (RTC) IS A STRENGTHS-BASED CONTINUUM OF COMPREHENSIVE TREATMENT SERVICES TO HEAL THE IMPACTS OF SEXUAL HARM IN NUU-CHAH-NULTH FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES. RTC IS QUU?AS BASED, TRAUMA-INFORMED AND HOLISTIC. WE ARE ON A JOURNEY OF HEALING FOR ALL AND RESTORING THE STRENGTH OF NUU-CHAH-NULTH COMMUNITIES.

REBUILDING THE CIRCLE IMPLEMENTS THE RTC TREATMENT MODEL BASED OFF OF THE EXPERTISE OF JANE MIDDELTON-MOZ AND THE RTC CORE TEAM.

What to expect:

- Intake is confidential; Pre-care counselling available to support readiness
- Sobriety time from alcohol, marijuana, and illicit substances is mandatory
- Bag checks upon arrival
- Medication will be logged and stored with staff
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided Monday to Friday. Access to onsite pantry for dinners and weekends.
- All clients are expected to stay onsite for the duration of program, including weekends
- Cell phones will be limited to before and after program only
